Please know that Bowditch does not have any access (and has minimal knowledge) to the refunding or payment process, so School Tours's customer service will often be the most helpful with financial questions.

<u>Scholarship</u>: Through School Tours of America, a scholarship is offered for students that might need assistance paying for the trip. Please reach out to Ms. Launer for further information.

Emails: If you have already signed up for the trip and are not receiving emails, please contact Ms. Launer ASAP. The email list is being pulled directly from School Tours' registration information, so it will be important to fix any communication issues as quickly as possible!
